Opportunity of the Public to address the DDA Board: Justin gave an update of the Water Project and that the Appropriation Request documents were completed and sent to Senator Peters and Stabenow's Offices for submission for 2024 appropriation request. They were due in by March 16, 2023. He noted that we need to follow up with 3 "letters of support" to finish the process.

## SPECIAL MEETING – APPROVAL OF SHIAWASSEE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION PROJECT - ASPHALT PAVING ROAD PROJECT FOR ROSE BLVD.

Chairman Piro had Mark Fulks give an overview of the Road Project. It was noted that the cost bidding has been competed by the Road Commission and it came in under the \$91,000 estimate we were given in mid January. In fact, once the bids came in Rose Blvd Paving Project came in at \$79,000. Mark also noted that the Perry Township Board had approved funding of \$30,000 towards this project at it Monthly Board Meeting in March.

Brian Pfeifle made a motion to approve a Not to Exceed amount of \$49,000 for the Rose Blvd Asphalt Paving with Chip Seal Road Project; Seconded by Phil Milliken.

Mark also noted that the DDA property for sale on Lansing Road passed the County Planning Commission last night in a 7 to 0 vote for changing the zoning from B-1 to M-2 as requested by the Township.
