She also asked about the ordinance on animals in subdivisions. She was told to contact Shiawassee County Community Development.

Sheriff Report: 24 traffic stops; 99 total calls for the month.

SSESA: Health Insurance costs are increasing. They are still recruiting EMT's and Paramedic's. The Fire Barn is hosting Safety Day on June 8th. Contract negotiations have begun.

DDA: Next meeting is July 17th. The Grant for the water loop was selected for review in Washington DC. Appropriation approval will be in Oct. 2025.

Zoning: Fence has been put on the poles on Thornapple Dr. A request for review of the ordinance was made to Pete Preston.

Library: A 2nd drop box has been placed at the back entrance for book drop off at the Perry Branch. The Library has a millage on the ballot in Aug.

Planning Comm: There has been discussion about new public gravel roads; removing the ability to have multi house driveways and review of potential township ordinance.

Correspondence: We received an email from the Shiawassee Chamber offering 100% subsidized LED 4' Tube Lights. Paperwork was filled out and the lights were sent. *We received notification that Acrisure (known as Spalding Ins) was moving to Howell. *We received an anonymous note regarding junk and debris at a location. The information was passed on to Shiawassee Code Enforcement. *We received notification that the City of Perry Planning Commission has drafted a Master Plan.
