Regular Meeting Minutes
May 7, 2025

The Supervisor opened the meeting with the pledge to the flag.

The **agenda was approved.** Parmalee moved; Fraser seconded. All ayes Carried.

The **April 2, 2025 Regular Meeting Minutes and the March 20, 2025 Budget Hearing were approved.** Parmalee moved; Griffith seconded. All ayes Carried.

Public Comment: Caroline Wilson came to the meeting for her semi-annual visit. She stated the updated directory can be printed online on the county website. Caroline also mentioned the results from the county wide early voting location showed a huge success in the early voting for the 2024 Presidential Primary, August Primary and the November General Election for Shiawassee County. By having 20 units of government going in together for the early voting, the costs were much lower shared than they would have been individually.

- Approved Sexton to spray brush killer for poison ivy on south back line of the cemetery and for ticks and mosquitoes. The mosquito and tick spray will be at \$925,

- May 6, 2025 Election- The May 6, 2025 Special Election went very smooth. We had a total of 505 voters of which 365 were AV ballots processed in the precinct.
